About the Program

This is a distance learning practitioner program in real time in our online classroom operated by professors of homeopathy at our satellite office in the United States for students in North America working towards CHC certification. The most accomplished homeopaths and professors of homeopathy in the world were students of Professor Vithoukas, and at IACH students learn directly from Professor George Vithoukas's lectures and wealth of homeopathic experience and knowledge. We welcome our new class of 2023 and are currently accepting applications for our 3-year program beginning on August 22, 2020. The deadline for application submission is July 10, 2020.

This program is a life changing experience for both experienced homeopaths and new students of homeopathy alike. Advanced homeopathic practitioners who have taken our course after many years of professional practice are astounded by how much more they learn from this course. *NOTE: Current CHC holders and also those who have previously graduated and received a diploma from IACH receive a 50% discount on tuition for the upcoming year.

Class Schedule

Classes for the 2020-2023 program will be held on Thursdays from 5 PM to 9 PM Arizona time, and also the first Tuesday of each month from 5 PM to 9 PM Arizona time. Orientation for the forthcoming year is August 22th, 2020 and classes begin August 27th, 2020. Classes are held online via Zoom. Cristina Chise is the primary instructor throughout this 3-year journey as students observe Professor Vithoukás' lectures. Prerequisites for the Course

We invite students to join our program from all different areas of expertise and study. A bachelor degree is preferred, and an associate degree or equivalent (60 credits) is required for admission. Also, students who have not taken Anatomy and Physiology and Pathology classes in their undergraduate program prior to taking our program need to also complete these certification prerequisites prior to finishing the 3-year program in order to receive an IACH diploma and to qualify to register to take the certification board exams for North America. Tuition & Fees

The total cost for the 3-Year North American Practitioner Program is \$9875.

The tuition for the 3-year Practitioner Program is \$9000 plus a nonrefundable \$50 registration fee. An additional fee of \$275 per annum for our 5-day summer clinic (last week of July each year) is due by July 1st of each year, and students are required to attend the summer clinic (via

Zoom) each of the 3 years of their enrollment. (Students who are already CHC are excused from Summer Clinic if they wish)

Students may make tuition payments on request for the following payment schedules:

- A lump sum payment of \$9000 may be made prior to entering the program
- An annual payment may be made of \$3000 prior to each new commencing year (no interest or financial penalty)
- A payment of \$1000 may be made 3 weeks prior to each semester (3 payments per year for 3 years with no interest or financial penalty)
- An additional fee of \$275 per annum for summer clinic is due by July 1st of each year enrolled - regardless of and in addition to tuition and payment plan.

Clinical Training

Our clinical training at IACH is woven throughout the course. In addition, IACH has three separate continuously updated annual clinic modules which are each a minimum of 50 hours for a total of 150 hours combined. These modules include recent cases taken by George Vithoukas as well as our international adjunct faculty. Students also participate in our live summer clinics with Cristina Chise, Cash Leo, and George Vithoukas (via Zoom). The summer clinics are 35 hours per annum (one week/5-days each summer), and students must attend three summers in a row for a total of 105 hours of Live Summer Clinic. These cases may be attended via Zoom as a webcam will be used during these clinics. Students, and friends and family of students are invited to participate and receive treatment (free of charge) during summer clinic weeks as students observe live case-taking, case analysis and prescribing from our faculty. Students are also offered the option of attending the Live Alonissos Clinics in Greece in lieu of the live summer clinic hours. Finally, students are also closely supervised as they take their own very first ten cases. These are a minimum of 140 hours total. Students also meet (one on one) with a North American Faculty instructor to thoroughly discuss their cases - a minimum of thirty times (total) for supervision and mentoring during their second and third years of the program.

*Note: Students who are already certified in classical homeopathy (CCH) are not required to participate in summer clinics or complete clinical modules.

Book Requirements

Books are the responsibility of the student to acquire and are not included in the tuition cost for the program. Following is a list of the minimum required books.
