About the Program

This is a distance learning practitioner program in real time in our online classroom operated by professors of homeopathy at our satellite office in the United States for students in North America. The most accomplished homeopaths and professors of homeopathy in the world were students of Professor Vithoukias, and at IACH students learn directly from Professor George Vithoukias's lectures and wealth of homeopathic experience and knowledge. We welcome our new class of 2025 and are currently accepting applications for our 3-year program beginning on August 27, 2022.

The deadline for application submission is August 20, 2022.

This program is a life changing experience for both experienced homeopaths and new students of homeopathy alike. Class Schedule

Classes for the 2022-2025 program will be held on Mondays from 5 PM to 9 PM Arizona time, and also the third Tuesday of each month from 5 PM to 9 PM Arizona time. Orientation for the forthcoming year will be held on August 27th, 2022 and classes begin August 29th, 2022. Classes are held online via Zoom. Cristina Horvath is the primary instructor throughout this 3-year journey as students observe Professor Vithoukas' lectures. Mrs. Cristina Horvath's 20+ years of experience in classical homeopathy, deep understanding of George Vithoukas teachings, and nurturing instruction helps to empower students to become successful and confident future practitioners in this healing art. Prerequisites for the Course

We invite students to join our program from all different areas of expertise and study. A bachelor degree is required for admission. Also, students who have not taken Anatomy, Physiology and Pathology classes in their undergraduate program prior to taking our program need to also complete these certification prerequisites prior to finishing the 3-year program in order to receive an IACH diploma. We recommend (where possible) taking the course in year one to

provide a foundational understanding with which to better approach the cases covered in the Practitioner Program and before students begin taking their own supervised cases in years 2 and 3.

Tuition & Fees

The total cost for the 3-Year North American Practitioner Program is \$12,875.

The tuition for the 3-year Practitioner Program is \$12,000 plus a nonrefundable \$50 registration fee. An additional fee of \$275 per annum for our Student Internship Clinic is due in two separate payments of \$412.50 prior to the second and third year of the program. Second and Third year students are required to attend the Student Internship Clinic (via Zoom) once a month on the 4th Tuesday of each month from 5 PM to 9 PM Arizona time.

Students may make tuition payments on request according to the following payment schedules:

- A lump sum payment of \$12,000 may be made prior to entering the program
- An annual payment of \$4000 may be made 3 weeks prior to each new commencing year (no interest or financial penalty)
- A payment of \$1333.33 may be made 3 weeks prior to each semester (3 payments per year for 3 years with no interest or financial penalty)

*An additional fee of \$412.50 per annum (prior to years 2 and year 3 only) for Student Internship Clinic is due by August 26th of year 2 and year 3 - regardless of and in addition to tuition and payment plan.

Clinical Training

Our clinical training at IACH is woven throughout the course. In addition, IACH has continuously updated clinic modules which are a minimum of 100 hours for a total of 200 hours of combined observation and study hours. These modules include recent cases taken by George Vithoukas as well as our international adjunct faculty. Students also participate in our IACH Student Internship Clinic with Cristina Horvath and Dr. Latika Jaggi (via Zoom) during the 2nd and 3rd year of the program, once per month for 4 hours. The Student Internship Clinic includes 80 hours of additional supervised clinical hours as students take and follow clinical cases. These cases may be attended via Zoom, as a webcam will be used during these clinics. Students, and friends and family of students are invited to participate and receive treatment (free of charge) during internship clinic sessions as students participate in and observe live case-taking, case analysis and prescribing from our student interns and faculty. Students are also offered the option of attending the Live Alonissos Clinics in Greece in lieu of the clinic module hours. More details about our courses in Alonissos can be found here:

Finally, students are also closely supervised as they take their own very first ten cases. These are a minimum of 140 hours total. Students also meet (one on one) with a North American Faculty instructor to thoroughly discuss their cases - a minimum of thirty times (total) for supervision and mentoring during their second and third years of the program.

Attendance

As this course utilizes immersion methodology and each class is uniquely and heavily saturated in case taking, patient intake, case analysis, and clinical training, we do not record classes in accordance with HIPAA regulations, and a strict 80% attendance policy in our distance learning classroom is strongly enforced in order that students may acquire the highest level of education

and training.

Practicing Homeopathy
